What is the INNOVAGE project?

The INNOVAGE project is dedicated to developing, testing as well as surveying and cataloguing, **social Innovations** for older people. Four new innovations will be developed and tested:

- a) social innovation for user – driven housing of older people,
- b) **a web-platform for informal carers of older people,**
- c) social intervention for improving obesity in old age,
- d) social innovation for activation of people with dementia living in long term care institutions.

Who is involved?

EUROCARERS and **INRCA** are involved in **INNOVAGE WP3** by developing a web platform addressing **informal carers'** needs, which will be implemented in all 27 EU member states with both common contents and national-specific ones. Additional national contents addressing **employers of working carers** and **care professionals** will be developed and implemented in certain EU countries.

As a EUROCARERS member, can I get involved?

Yes, the involvement of **EUROCARERS member organizations** is a key part for the development of the web platform, which will provide quality web services according to the specific needs of carers.

There are several ways for you to participate in the development of the platform:

- a) **by taking part in on-line surveys**
- b) **by developing national contents for your country.**
- c) **by disseminating the web platform in national and local level in your country**

Development of national contents is estimated to start in September 2014.

A dissemination plan, starting officially in 2015, will involve presentation and training of the web platform to carers, care professionals and employers.

Activities will include EU events with Eurocarers representatives as well as national and local events.

Development of national contents and dissemination activities will be reimbursed.
